All students in Grandmaster Han's are expected to follow the training principles: **Be Polite, Be Patient, Be Alert, Be Brave, Do Your Best, Respect Yourself and Others.**

The Youn Wha Youth Development Program goes a step further. Students are given guidance in understanding and applying the principles. Positive habits take time to develop. So, each student is tasked with practicing the principles in smaller, understandable steps. For example, they will be asked to randomly demonstrate a principle such as being polite. A suggestion would be to respond to adults with Yes Sir or Yes Ma'am. Another suggestion would be to help carry groceries without being asked.

An application of being brave would be to resist negative peer pressure. An example would be to resist the encouragement by peers to tease or bully another child. This would also support respect for one's self and others. Someone who respects his or her self has no need to put others down to feel better.

Each student will be congratulated during class for sharing how they applied the training principles in their daily life.
